



OVERVIEW





-> membership increased by 32% compared to the previous year.



In 2023, AIWC and its members also arranged a number of other events:






- 1. AIWC Spring GALA Events, May 13th. The GALA was a tremendous success, with 170 members and partners attending. Through dedicated fundraising activities like sponsorships and a raffle, the event helped raise 3,610,000 tenge for the charitable organizations that AIWC supports and 1 million in kind donation.
- 2. Christmas Brunch, December 3rd. The brunch has become a cherished tradition, allowing children and their families to visit Santa, sing holiday carols, and mingle over brunch. The event was also very successful in raising 995,000 tenge for our charity organizations!

Eldany Charitable Foundation



Ark Village focuses on supporting children in need, particularly orphans and those from disadvantaged backgrounds. The organization aims to provide a nurturing environment, educational opportunities, and various developmental programs to help these children thrive.

Seven Trees focuses on social welfare, support for disadvantaged communities, environmental initiatives, or promoting education and cultural activities. Their focus is on women. They may engage in activities such as providing food, shelter, educational resources, and medical assistance to those in need.

Eldany focuses on supporting various social initiatives and community development projects. The foundation typically aims to improve the quality of life for underprivileged groups, including children, families in crisis, and individuals in need of social and medical support

DARA Foundation focuses on a variety of social, educational, and health initiatives aimed at improving the welfare of disabled children and vulnerable populations. The foundation often engages in projects that provide support for orphanages, educational programs, health campaigns, and social integration efforts for those in need.

Our charity engagements (1)



a. Seven Trees (1,661,000 tenge)

- For women's day, we funded and helped pack special gift bags for women, and through this provided toiletry items and important daily products to women in need.
- As part of our Gala fundraising activity, Kaspi provided Back to School Kids worth 1million tenge to Seven Tree families.
- We also provided financial support to fund the summer camp for children in need.

b. Ark Village (1,015,200 tenge)

- We supported the general activities of his orphanage by donating 1 million TT
- At the village's holiday party, our very talented members also conducted special arts and crafts projects with the children.


